
**WRITTEN DETERMINATION REGARDING THE APPOINTMENT OF  
OUTSIDE COUNSEL ON BEHALF OF THE WEST VIRGINIA  
DIVISION OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (hereinafter “West Virginia DNR”) has requested legal representation in conjunction with the acquisition of property situated in Preston County. The property is situated in the Valley District of Preston County, and consists of approximately 636.567 acres owned by Donna J. Rehe and the Estate of Harold J. Rehe. The West Virginia DNR is in need of an attorney to abstract the title, prepare a title report, prepare the deed, and hold the closing on or before November 29, 2013.

In accordance with the Attorney General’s Policy on Outside Counsel (Policy #WVAGO-004), the Office of the Attorney General has determined that it is both cost-effective, and in the interest of the public to appoint outside counsel to assist the West Virginia DNR with the purchase of the subject property:

- The matter at issue requires particular expertise in real estate transactional law not currently possessed by the Office of the Attorney General.
- The legal services needed would require a significant time commitment from the Office of the Attorney General to familiarize itself with real estate transactional work.
- There is a particular need for a private attorney with experience handling real estate transactions.
- The geographic area where the services are to be performed (Preston County) makes appointment more cost-effective than the services that could be provided by the Office of the Attorney General.
- It is not feasible or cost-effective for the Office of the Attorney General to provide the requested legal services.

Accordingly, the Attorney General authorizes the appointment of outside counsel in the current legal matter pursuant to commencement of the request for proposal process laid out in subsection (D) of Policy #WVAGO-004.
