**WRITTEN DETERMINATION APPOINTING
OUTSIDE COUNSEL ON BEHALF OF
THE OFFICE OF THE WEST VIRGINIA ATTORNEY GENERAL**

The Office of the West Virginia Attorney General (hereinafter "WVAGO") is in need of legal representation to assist with the bankruptcy recently filed by Mallinckrodt PLC and its affiliates and subsidiaries in Federal Bankruptcy Court in District of Delaware.

Pursuant to the written determination issued on November 30, 2020, the Office of the Attorney General determined that it was both cost-effective and in the interest of the public to appoint outside counsel to assist WVAGO with the needed legal services. A request for proposals, RFP # 94, was issued in accordance with subsection (D) of the Attorney General's Policy on Outside Counsel (Policy #WVAGO-004).

As of the December 7, 2020, deadline for proposals, the Office of the Attorney General received three timely proposals for legal services. After a review of the proposals received, the Office has determined that the law firm of Leech Tishman Fuscaldo & Lampl, LLC ("Leech Tishman") submitted the most competitive proposal for legal services pursuant to Section E of Policy # WVAGO-004, based on the following factors:

- Leech Tishman possess the required specialized legal experience that is not currently possessed by the Office of the Attorney General.
- Leech Tishman can provide the needed legal services in a timely manner and at a competitive rate.

Based on the factors set forth above, the Office of the Attorney General authorizes the appointment of Leech Tishman to serve as outside counsel for the legal matters cited herein pursuant to Section (E) of Policy # WVAGO-004.
